History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: This was the only mill in the Rubicon forest to survive the 1939 fire, and some huts also escaped the blaze. The mills were established on the oppposite sides of the Royston River in 1937 and 1931 respectively, and operated in tandemby the most successful and long lived timber company in the Rubicon Forest. The last remaining tramway in the Rubicon Forest served this and No.5 mill.
