## History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The settlement of Matlock sprang up in 1863 and expanded rapidly. It developed as a centre for "Grand Balls and Entertainments" and this remained its reputation. By 1865 it boasted seven hotels, three restaurants, seven stores, a bakery, two butchers, two banks, one sharebroker and a few private residences. In December 1873 the town was almost completely burnt out in a bushfire. The remaining inhabitants moved down the hill to re-establish the town on a new site.
