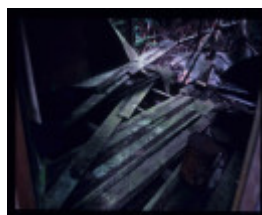

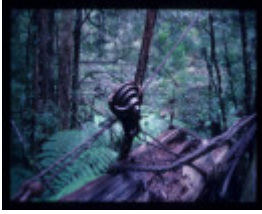

History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The skyline was used in the mid 1940s to bring logs to the tramline where a Fordson rail tractor hauled the trucks to the top of the incline. Once lowered down the incline the logs were hauled to Ingrams Mill. Road trucks took over this section after 1949.
