The Stawell Brick Company Pty Ltd, 2-6 Griffith Street, Stawell appears to have operated from this site since the 1890s and throughout the 20th century. The two tall brick chimneys are local landmarks.

The Stawell Brick Company Pty Ltd, 2-6 Griffiths Street, Stawell is **aesthetically** significant at a **LOCAL** level. The two tall brick chimneys are local landmarks.

The Stawell Brick Company Pty Ltd, 2-6 Griffith Street is historically significant at a **LOCAL** level. It is associated with industrial development in Stawell in the 19th and 20th centuries and its relationship to the building industry.

Physical Description 1

The brickworks site is a collection of utilitarian buildings mainly masked from view by the brick stacks in the yard. The major landmarks of the site are the brick stacks and the two tall brick chimneys that can be viewed from many places within the town.
