The area of scatter is completely level. The tank, trough and windmill are more recent structures / used up until recent times. However, the fallen windmill and tank suggest greater antiquity.

Heritage Inventory History of Site:

The history of this site is largely unknown. The original structure, associated with scatter, is assumed to be at least 50 years old. The trough, tank and windmill have been more recently used and an inscription dated 1960 on the trough indicate date of construction
