The site is possibly part of the Buchanan's sawmill complex which was sites east of Muddy Creek in the 1860s. Timber was brought to the mill on tramways and also taken to by tram to the port on Corner Inlet to the south. The population of the Buchanan mill settlement grew to about 200 people, but flourished for a few years only. It ceased to operate during the 1870s.
