No specific references were found regarding the retreatment of tailings generated by the mining of Beligian Reef. In the late 1870s, tailings were being retreated on Bealiba Reef, by the Queens Birthday Company. Part of the equipment employed by this company was Chilian mills. By the mid 1890s cyaniding of battery sand was being carried out in the Victorian goldfields.
