Interpretation of Site	Manager's residence here from at least 1894. The Cleghorn tannery was started by Cleghorn, but later taken over by Hallenstein with Cleghorn remaining manager. The house was later replaced by a brick office in 1952. Further buildings to the north.
Historical Significance	Cleghorn tannery associated with the Hallenstein tannery and form a huge tannery complex. Operated from the 1860's. Important early industry for Footscray. Noxious industry now phased out.
Archaeological Significance	Currently a Beaurepaire centre here with a large asphalt carpark at the front. It is likely the remains of these earliest sites could be preserved beneath this carpark area.
