Historical Significance Mid 19th Century residence superceded by an early 20th Century warehouse associated with a tannery, located within a residential and industrial precinct on the Maribynnong river in Footscray. Associated with important historical developments for Footscray.

Archaeological Significance

Currently an open plan warehouse stands in this lacation. Given there were two earlier phases of developement here, it is moderately likely that intact structural remains and associated desposits remain here below ground.
