History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: Site is marked on 1912 map. Later orchard. Stone house and stables built by William Herbert in 1861. Farm called 'Greenhills'. Property also held first horse race in 1884-86/7 with dances held in the barn afterwards. Sometime after 1887, a weatherboard home built further up hill due to frequent inundation. House and barn were still standing in 1988. Last used as an orchard shed.
