The existing brick hotel appear to be substantially intact, save for the detracting and unsympathetic awnings over the door and one window, and the bricking up of the corner entrance. The plain brick building has recessed . ' arch headed windows which are accentuated by deep plaster bands with large panelled keystones. The plaster bands spring from a moulding at most height and which, with a lower band, links the windows. The long facade terminates in' ,,doubled window. Another band of contrasting work joins the windows at sill' level and below each window is a recessed panel of brickwork. The ground floor windows are treated in a similar fashion, but here the windows have cast iron window guards which may be original.

The hotel is an important corner element in the streetscape
