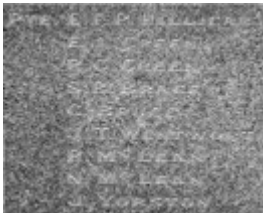

The War Memorial is a World War One granite obelisk memorial, with an engraving to World War Two on the side. The World War One inscription is on a plaque attached to the front of the memorial and reads: ' Great European War 1914 - 1918. Erected as a tribute to the memory of our brave men who gave their lives for the honor of Australia an the cause of liberty. Lest we forget'. The memorial is on a concrete base and with a concrete post and pipe fence enclosing it.

The Strath Creek War Memorial is a granite obelisk memorial, commemorating the First World War, with a later engraving to the Second World War on the side. The First World War inscription is on a plaque attached to the front of the memorial and reads: '*Great European War 1914 - 1918. Erected as a tribute to the memory of our brave men who gave their lives for the honor of Australia and the cause of liberty. Lest we forget*'. The memorial is on a concrete base and with a concrete post and pipe fence enclosing it. The land was purchased for the site of the War Memorial in 1915 from a Mr Lane.
