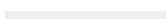

Typical of a full forest sawmill in the mid-20th century.

Interpretation of Site Foundation timbers relate to skids in the log yard, foundations for the breaking-down track, the rip bench and stacking skids. Chimney foundations and scattered domestic debris gives some indication of the size of the mill community.

History

THE MILL WAS ESTABLISHED BY WILLIAM HENRY FROUD AND HIS SONS ALFRED AND JAMES IN THE LATE 1920S TO EXPLOIT THE YELLOW STRINGYBARK TIMBER OF THE MULLUNGUNG FOREST. THE KAURI TIMBER COMPANY TOOK OVER THE MILL IN 1946 WHICH CONTINUED TO OPERATE UNTIL MID-1948.
