Since its completion in 1924 this substantial war memorial has been something of a local landmark in addition to its primary role as the focus in Kyneton for remembering those killed in action in both wars and also associated occasions, particularly Anzac Day. The location of the memorial at the major intersection in the centre of the town and the memorial's size and quality of detailing, including a bronze wreath and complete with fence, illustrate the resources of the Kyneton community at that time and the importance of this memorial to them.

## Veterans Description for Public

The Kyneton War Memorial, on the South-west corner of Mollison Street and Baynton Street, was erected in 1924 to commemorate the First World War, with names added for those who served in the Second World War. The memorial is a local landmark and the focus in Kyneton for remembering those killed in action in both wars, especially on Anzac Day. It comprises of a column mounted on a three tiered base. The location of the memorial at the major intersection in the centre of the town and the memorial's size and quality of detailing, including a bronze wreath and complete with pillar fence, illustrate the resources of the Kyneton community at that time and the importance of this memorial to them.
