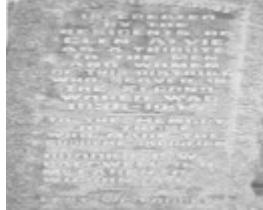

The Glen Alvie War Memorial, in the H.C. Berry Reserve, comprises of a pair of stone gateposts with a brick wall and a pair of flagpoles. The memorial is dedicated to both the fallen and returned servicemen of the Second World War, it lists twenty-nine names in total.
