The Wonthaggi War Memorial is located in the Soldiers Reserve, McBride Avenue, Wonthaggi, Bass Coast Shire. It is a rendered white brick obelisk, featuring bronze plaques inscribed with honour lists of the local men who served in the First World War and the Second World War. Plaques have been added to the memorial in honour of Royal Australian Navy, Army and Airforce and for the Boer War, Korea and Vietnam.
