The Horsham and District World War I Memorial Drive, on McBryde Street and McPherson Street (off the Western Highway), comprises of Eucalyptus trees and a granite wall with a bronze plaque marking it as the - "Horsham & District World War I Memorial Drive." Unfortunately most of the trees have died or been removed for road widening. No name plaques are evident on any of the remaining trees.
