The Belmont War Memorial comprises of a stone obelisk in the middle of two smaller memorial walls, in front of the RSL Hall at 50 Barwon Heads Road. The two memorials are dwarf walls (approximately 1.5 metres and 3 metres long) constructed of brick and contain two plaques each. The plaques on the north wall read: "To the Memory of those who gave their lives in the Vietnam Campaign", and "To the Memory of those who gave their lives in the Malayan Campaign". The plaques on the south wall read: "To the Memory fo those who gave their lives in the Korean War", and "To the Memory of those who gave their lives in the 2nd World War 1939-1945."
