The Doncaster War Memorial was established on August 13th 2000 outside the Doncaster RSL. The memorial comprises of a wall with a series of plaques naming 386 locals (fallen and returned) who served in the First World War, Second World War, Korea and Vietnam. The wall includes plaques relocated from the memorial formerly located on the facade of the Athenaeum Hall.
