

#### **Veterans Description for Public**

The Concongella War Memorial is located off Landsborough Road in the cemetery drive. At the entrance to the Memorial and Cemetery are two rows of mature pine trees, terminating with the War Memorial. The War Memorial consists of a narrow granite obelisk having an elongated base and stepped plinth. Fence posts and round steel rails define the memorial boundaries. Marble tablets affixed to the memorial list the names of the soldiers who fought and died in the First World War. One tablet also reads, "In Memory of Our Soldiers Who Fell in the Great War 1914-19, Lest We Forget".
