Eaglehawk War Memorial located in Brassey Square, Eaglehawk, consists of an obelisk characterised by plaques and wreath ornamentation. Unveiled on August 5th 1922, the memorial commemorates locals that served in the First World War, Second World War, Korea, Malaya and Vietnam.
