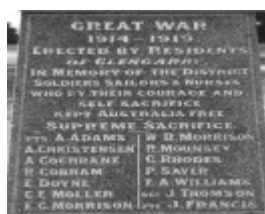

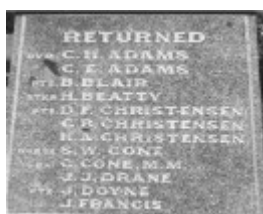

The Glengarry War Monument, on Main Street and Cairnbrook Road, was erected on 22nd December 1920. The monument comprises of a stone obelisk and lists the names of sixty-six servicemen who fought in the Boer War, First and Second World Wars.
