Park with war memorials. Memorial Cenotaph and Gates. Outside central reserve, Springvale Road. Dedicated to the memory of those who made the supreme sacrifice during the wars since 1914, and to all who served their country. The pine tree is a direct descendant of the Lone Pine at Gallipoli.

Veterans Description for Public

The Mount Waverley War Memorials, on 385 Springvale Road, comprises of a cenotaph and gates, outside the central reserve. The memorials are dedicated to the memory of those who made the supreme sacrifice during conflicts since the First World War, and to all who served their country.
