The Mornington War Memorial, located in the Memorial Park at Barkly and Empire Streets, commemorates the First and Second World Wars and Vietnam. It resembles a cross mounted on a three tiered base, with bronze plaques listing the names of those who served and an inscription explaining, "*This Memorial Which Was Originally erected on 18th October 1925, at the intersection of Nepean Highway and Main Street Mornington, was rededicated on this site on 15th March, 1970.*"
