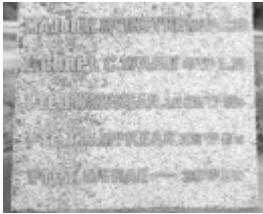

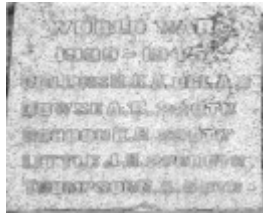

The Port Campbell War Memorial, located on Lord Street opposite the Beacon Steps, was erected in 1921. The memorial consists of a granite obelisk dedicated to those residents who died fighting in the First World War and Second World War.
