History

PROPERTY FARMED BY MICHAEL LYNCH FROM 1853 BUT LEASED TO JAMES HENNESSY AND RICHARD PLANT IN 1860S. OWNERSHIP PASSED TO SON WILLIAM LYNCH IN 1871 UNTIL HIS DEATH IN 1902. DURING W LYNCHJ'S OWNERSHIP, PROPERTY LEASED TO DAIRY FARMERS HENDERSON (FROM 1870S-1880S) AND JS MORGAN (1890S). MORGAN DAIRY FARMED ON LARGE SCALE IN EPPING, DURING LYNCH'S WONERSHIP THERE WERE NO MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS. BLUESTONE FORD LIKELY RELATED TO DAIRY FARMING OPERATIONS SURING W LYNCH'S OWNERSHIP (1870S-1900S).
