## History

THE 1855 PLAN SHOWS THIS AS A HOUSE SET BACK FROM MORELAND STREET ON LOT 6 SECTION V TOWNSHIP OF FOOTSCRAY. OWNED BY JOSEPH IRVINE. POSSIBLY SHOWN IN 1864 BUT DEFINITELY

NOT THERE ON THE 1877 MAP. THERE IS A BUILDING ON THE SITE ON THE 1895 MMBW PLANS BUT THE BLOCK IS SHOWN AS VACANT AGAIN ON THE 1910 PLAN. STYLISTICALLY, THE BUILDING IS 1920S IN ORIGIN.
