History

ON THE 1855 MAP, THE SITE IS DIVIDED INTO THREE ZONES - CHURCH, PARSONAGE AND SCHOOL WITH A SMALL RECTANGULAR BUILDING ON THE CHURCH SITE. PRESUMABLY, THIS WAS A SMALL CHURCH. THIS IS NOT ON THE COX 1864 MAP AND A LARGER BUILDING IS ON THE SITE INSTEAD. THE 1877 PLAN SHOWS A CHURCH (PRESUMABLY THE CURRENT ST MONICA'S) AND A SMALL OUTBUILDING. THE 1895 PLAN SEEMS TO CONFIRM THIS ALTHOUGH THE THE OUTBUILDING IS NOW AT THE REAR OF THE CHURCH. THE 1910 PLAN SHOES THE ADDITION OF THE PRESBYTERY.
