Interpretation of Site	The site represents an area where Europeans needed a supply of water and they constructed a well. In time the need for water at this spot has passed and the well fell into disuse and disrepair, finally becoming ruined.
Archaeological Significance	This well has a low archaeological significance as it is in such a poor condition and these types of wells are common within Victoria. Some archaeological potential exists to excavate the well contents, thereby allowing an indication (through analysis of discarded items in the well) of the period and type of usage of this feature.
Historical Significance	The well holds a medium historical significance for its potential ability to provide information regarding aspects of an earlier period of rail travel in Victoria. More research is required to provide a context for use.
