THE KUNAT SCHOOL SITE REPRESENTS SCHOOLING IN THE ISOLATED AREAS OF THE MALLEE DURING THE PERIOD 18902-1950S WHEN THIS AREA WAS MORE CLOSELY SETTLED THAN TODAY.

Interpretation of Site	There are no visible remains of the foundations of the school, however there is a number of historic artefacts scattered around the trees and in the paddock. As the school was a timber building, there may not be any sub-surface foundations.

## History

THE SCHOOL OPENED AS KOOEM EAST SCHOOL SS3294 IN 1896. IT CLOSED BRIEFLY DUE TO DROUGHT IN 1903 AND RE-OPENED IN 1904. IN 1915 THE SCHOOL NAME WAS CHANGED TO KUNAT. THE SCHOOL CLOSED IN 1934 AND RE-OPENED AGAIN IN 1951, THEN CLOSED IN 1954. THE KUNAT HALL WAS USED FOR A SCHOOL. AROUND 1956, THE JUNAT HALL WAS SOLD AND MOVED TO LAKE BOGA. IN 1982 IT WAS SOLD FOR DEMOLITION.
