## History

Harts boatbuilding yard stood sandwiched between the Ferguson St Pier and The Dredging Depot, and constructed small boats and yachts (WA, 28/9/1889; WC, 11/10/1890). The boatyard was offered for sale in 1893 (WA, 18/3/1893), and the land appears to have been purchased by the Hobsons Bay Yacht Club, who still occupy

the site.
