Interpretation of Site

The wall appears to have been originally installed as part of land reclamation works to fill in a former bay between the Williamstown Steam Ferry Landing and the current Oil wharves site. Local divers (John Howell, MAAV) have reported the remains of the seawall are still visible underwater a few metres north of the Old Yarra River Course Stone Embankments (H7822-0430). The site is important due to the potential earlier timber fabric beneath the current wall.
