1860: allotments 32 and 33 sold to John Smith

1863: John Smith leased the land to Peter Cusack

1869: land sold to Thomas Blenkiron, then sold to Robert Seviour

1874: sold to Peter Hanson

1910: sold to Alfred Emmanuel Bassett
