History

Snelson's Boatyard and Slipway, produced small yachts and steamers, and later became Fitzsimmons Boat Hire (Somerville, pers comms). Snelson also ran a boat hire service from 1895. Fitzsimmon's boathouse was located near Chifley Drive, and hired out boats during the 1920's.
