History

Local information has it that James Stewart was a shanty proprietor on the old Gillingall Road, who asphyxiated after drinking a batch of his own powerful brew. James was 53 years old when he died on 6 Dec 1881. He was the son of Joseph Stewart, of Inverness-shire Scotland. Stewart was listed as a grazier on death certificate.
