Interpretation of Site	Paddock was the site of two houses. One was destroyed between 1977 - 1984, the other post 1984.
Archaeological Significance	Ground surface visibility was low. However, the site appears to maintain a low level of integrity and intactness. There is potential for evidence to remain associated with the two structures that were formerly located on the site.
Historical Significance	The site is of local historical significance for its association with the development of Diggers Rest and local farming industry.

History

Land purchased from the Crown in 1856 by John Aitken. A 1977 topographic map shows 2 structures, both with separate driveways. A 1984 map shows only one structure. No structures remain.
