Site lies within former 'Egglestone Estate' established by Henry and John Cooke in early 1850s. The western end of the subdivision was into small blocks. This site lies at the very southern section of blocks abutting a nominated flour and saw mill reserve. It is not known who may have owned this land prior to the present.
