### Statement of Significance

Last updated on -

A very large eucalypt growing near the south east corner of the Dorset Gardens site, about 90 metres west of Larissa Court Reserve. It is presently regarded as intermediate between Scentbark (*Eucalyptus* aff. *ignorabilis*) and a rough barked Manna Gum (*Eucalyptus viminalis*) and is of scientific significance because it does not conform to recognised species and does not seem to be a hybrid. It is growing among *Eucalyptus cephalocarpa* in a very moist location.
