The Birchip Soldiers Memorial, located in the Birchip RSL Memorial Park, was unveiled November 11th 2007 by Ken K.Kemp (Ex R.A.A.F. Flying Officer WWII). The Memorial comprises of a Digger statue in the standing at ease. Plaques on the statue's base are dedicated to the 90th Anniversary of the Galliopli landing and the 60th Anniversary of the end of the Second World War.
