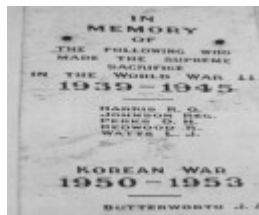

Veterans Description for Public

The Bridgewater Memorial Hall and Free Library, on Eldon and Erskine Streets, was established October 3rd 1923. The front entrance of the Hall lists the names of 215 fallen and returned soldiers who fought in the First World War, Second World War and Korea.

A Vietnam Veterans plaque recognising those who enlisted while living in Bridgewater, or who were born in Bridgewater, was added to the Memorial and unveiled on 25 April 2011. The plaque lists the following names:
