Caulfield Memorial Park was officially opened by Mayor Alan Grossbard on November 23rd 1997. The park includes a central paved ring, where several memorial plaques have been re-sited from their former position in

Avenues of Honour along North Road, McMillan Street and Point Nepean Road. The plaques commemorate the district servicemen who fell in the First World War.
