The VP Day (Victory in the Pacific) Memorial Tree in Queen's Park was planted to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the end of the Second World War. The tree was planted on August 15th 1995, fifty years after Japan accepted the Allied demand of unconditional surrender in the Pacific on August 15th 1945.
