#### **Veterans Description for Public**

The Lower Ferntree Gully Memorial Wall is located behind the First World War Memorial Obelisk on Dorset Road. The wall is constructed out of red tiles and features an artist's depiction of battle scenes in the Boer War, First World War, Second World War, Korea, Malaya and Vietnam. It was unveiled by C.R. D.G. Lucas and Cr. W.H. Tew at 11am, 11th November 1988.
