The Hamilton Gallipoli Memorial is located beside the lake. The memorial consists of a plaque with a relief map of the Gallipoli peninsula, marked with the significant places and dates of various battles of the Allied campaign against Turkish forces. There is also a memorial planting of a Pine tree and some Rosemary bushes, which have grown from cuttings brought back from the Gallipoli Peninsula.
