The Kangaroo Flat Soldiers Memorial, on the Calder Highway and View Street, comprises of a granite obelisk set upon three small flights of stairs. The monument is dedicated to the memory of the First World War, Second World War, Korea, Malaya, Borneo, Vietnam and Kuwait. Originally erected in 1914, the monument lists the names of 17 fallen residents who fought in the First World War and 6 names those who fell during the Second World War.
