The Maribyrnong War Memorial, inside McDonald Gardens, comprises of a stone obelisk erected on 30th April 1922. First dedicated to the First World War, it now includes dedications to the Second World War, Malaya, Korea and Vietnam. The main inscription is an excerpt from Robert Laurence Binyon's poem *For The Fallen* (1914), "At the going down of the sun and in the morning we will remember them."
