



The Narre Warren North Soldier Settlement Memorial Garden, in Kalora Park, is dedicated to the returned servicemen and their families who farmed the area between 1934 - 1975. The settlement blocks averaged 15 acres in size and were used for dairy and poultry production. The garden was officially opened by Mayor Cr. Janet Halsall on 1st March 2008. The soldier settlers listed on the plaque are Thomas and Annie Edwards, Edward and May Ivens, Leslie and Mary Lowry, John and Kathleen Rogers, Alfred and Sarah Sherriff, Francis and Jessie Stephenson, Arthur and Lila Street.
