### Veterans Description for Public

The WWII Memorial Gates, on Kilmore Road, were unveiled on 25th June 1950 by Lieutenant-General Sir Edmund Herring in front of a crowd of 400 people. The memorial comprises of ornamental, wrought iron gates attached to dressed bluestone pillars that feature bronze plaques with the names of those who served.
