The Warrnambool Vietnam Memorial Flagstaff, on Liebig Street and Merris Street, was erected on 9th February 2003. The memorial honours those who served in the Vietnam War. The front panel of the wall features a photo of a battle scene in Vietnam. The wall is also dedicated to those who served in Korea, Malaya, Borneo, peace keeping forces and in hazardous services since the Second World War.
