Interpretation of Site	The Beaufort-Lexton Road Mine feature is a deep lead mine which operated during the early 20th century.
Archaeological Significance	Despite the fact that mine sites are common in this region, Beaufort-Lexton Road Mine contains moderate archaeological significance. It has potential for in situ archaeological deposits relating to the early 20th century gold mine.
Historical Significance	The site is significant at a local level as an example of an early 20th century gold mine, possibly relating to the inter war period.
